BEFORE INSTALLATION

Inspection: Before installation, inspect all parts for shipping damage. If any of the parts appear damaged or questionable, DO NOT INSTALL! Contact your dealer or our facility for a replacement part or assistance. Once a product is installed, it cannot be returned because of shipping damage.

TOOLS NEEDED:

Drill with 32" Drill Bit, 5/16" Socket or 5/16" Wrench, Allen Wrench



Note: 5/16 x 1-1/4" lag bolts and washers are provided, however you may need longer bolts depending on the mounting location.

MOUNTING BRACKET



1. Position

Identify a solid flat area that will hold the weight of the flagpole system and position.



2. Mark

Mark the top point in all four openings of the plate.



3. Drill

Using a 1/32" drill bit, pre-drill holes in the material through marked positions.



4. Insert Lag Bolts

Insert $5/16 \times 1-1/4''$ Lag bolts with washers through flagpole holder mounting bracket and into the previously drilled holes.

Note: Remove any protective PVC coating from bracket.

ATTACHING FLAG






7. Attach Flag To the Top Spring Clip

Attach flag to flagpole using the spring snap.

8. Adjusting for Flag Size and Tighten



To accommodate flags of varying sizes, the collar on the flagpole adjusts up and down. Simply loosen the set screw in the collar and move the collar up or down. Once you have the collar positioned at the correct height, retighten the set screw.



9. Attach Flag To the Bottom Spring Clip



INSERT FLAG POLE INTO HOLDER





10. Remove Screw

11. Insert Flag Pole into Holder


Remove the screw in the flag pole holder before inserting the flag pole.





12. Reinsert Screw and Washer

Insert the screw with washer (that was removed earlier) back into the flag pole holder to secure the flag pole into the holder. Then tighen screw.
